Please help us continue the work we do. This year we would like to further grow our Patient Emergency Assistant Fund Program.

The Patient Emergency Assistance Fund Program (PEAF) is a tool to help hemodialysis and kidney transplant patients, often overwhelmed by their circumstance take the correct steps in managing their health challenges. It's a compassionate response to aid dialysis patients with their greatest needs as they transition from being independent to relying on dialysis three times a week. The fund provides emergency cash assistance with the following four specific services:

Public Transportation Assistance—allows patients, when normal means of transportation is unavailable, to get to their scheduled dialysis treatments.

Medication Assistance—supports patients with the purchase of life-supporting medications.

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Medication Assistance—supports patients with the purchase of life-supporting medications.

Renal Nutritional Supplement Assistance—allows patients experiencing low nutrition levels to receive supplements to increase their nutrition levels.

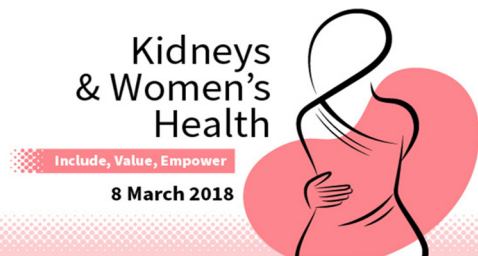
Medical Equipment Assistance—provides patients help with medical equipment necessary to maintain independence—walkers, shower chairs, blood pressure monitors, etc.

All services offered are managed by KFCP and coordinated through the social worker at each dialysis center. Assistance is intended to supplement the cost of a particular need and not intended to cover the full cost.

At KFCP, our top priority is ensuring a quality experience for all those impacted by CKD. Providing the support and resources to experience an exceptional outcome is the responsibility that drives the decisions we make.
